<u>Enerstar/Man Camps</u>: Enerstar rentals has requested approval to set up a man camp for a gas well located approximately 12 miles from the 168 Stanford Road (240-4F94-32BA). A motion was made by Mr. Saunders and seconded by Mr. Jesteadt to approve for a man camp located on the 168 Stanford Road for sixty days with one 30 day extension. A septic permit and building permit will be required for each unit. If the camp will be set up for longer than 90 days or if any additional requests for a man camp is requested, the property owner will be required to complete a land development plan. All in favor.
